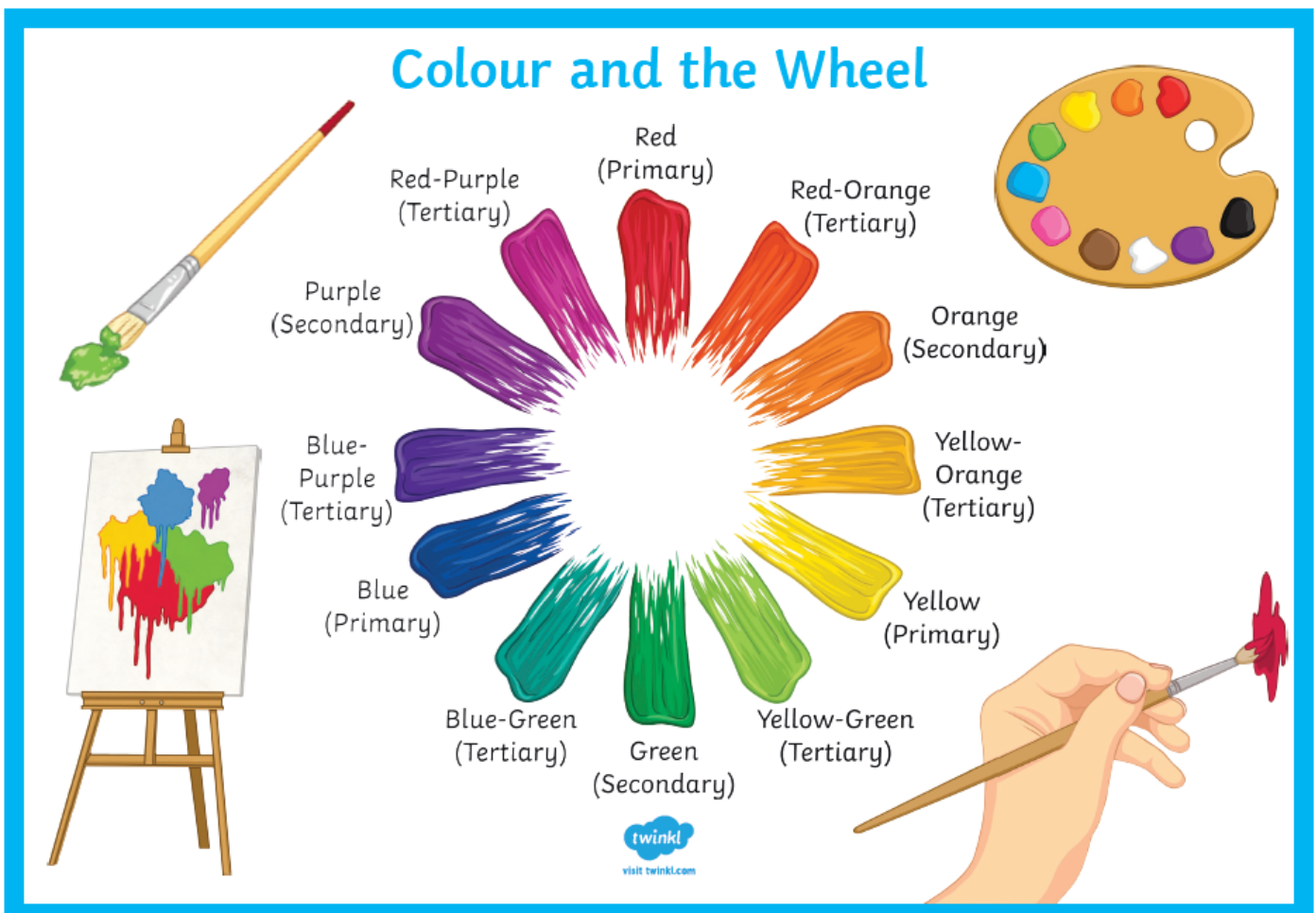

While you collect your materials for your creative activities, you can think about these new words:

- **Primary:** red, blue, yellow
- **Secondary:** orange, green, purple
- **Tertiary:** colours made by mixing primary and secondary colours





### Colour Wheel Collage

Hunt through magazines, newspapers and catalogues to find different colours.

Snip them out and collect them together in groups.

Stick the colour collections down onto segments from the colour wheel.

Put it all together to create your own colour wheel!

Collecting enough materials for your wheel might take a while so you can do this over a few days or a whole week.



## Activity 1



### Colour Wheel Collection

Go on a colour hunt around your home, garden or while on a walk.

Collect together items which are shades of the same colour.

Once you have found at least one item from every colour, find somewhere flat and arrange them in a circle to create your own object colour wheel.
